**DID YOU KNOW?**

The Twelve Apostles were formed by erosion. The harsh and extreme weather conditions from the Southern Ocean gradually erode the soft limestone to form caves in the cliffs, which then become arches that eventually collapse, leaving rock stacks up to 50 metre high. The stacks are susceptible to further erosion from waves. In July 2005, a 50-metre-tall stack collapsed, leaving seven standing at the Twelve Apostles viewpoint.

The stacks were originally known as the Pinnacles, and the Sow and Piglets, with Muttonbird Island, which stands at the mouth of Loch Ard Gorge, and her Piglets(the smaller rock stacks) were the 12 Apostles.

The formation's name was made official sometime in the 20th century as the Twelve Apostles, despite only ever having had eight stacks.

The apostles boast splendid names such as Razorback, Island Archway, Thunder Cave, Bakers Oven Rock, Sentinel Rocks and the Grotto
