APIA (SAMOA) / 02 February



Auckland, or Tāmaki Makaurau as its known in Māori, is New Zealand's multicultural and multifaceted capital, a green and gorgeous city sprawled across two harbours and 48 volcanic cones that create a unique urban landscape. You'll be immersed in lush native rainforests, rolling hills, dramatic black sand beaches and tranquil bays for a city visit like no other.


PETROPAVLOVSK (RUSSIA) / 03-04 May
